Attwenger tour the USA

With a wild mix of folk, punk and hip hop, Attwenger are certainly one of the most exciting and talked-about formations in the Austrian music scene. For over two decades the Upper Austrian duo consisting of Markus Binder (drums, vocals) and Hans-Peter Falkner (button accordion, vocals) has been taking listeners on a crossgenre thrill ride. Playing with languages and mixing genres is Attwenger's name of the game. In the course of their development, the band engaged in various adaptations of traditional folk music combined with Austrian dialect. Elements of punk, hip-hop, blues, break-core and drum'n' bass contributed to the typical Attwenger sound, which has emerged as a unique mastery of central European folklore.


Amadeus Austrian Music Awards: The Nominees are...


