In the end, the bottom line was 32 days recording in the studio and then another 16 days and nights mixing and finalising the tunes. Trouble Over Tokio



The British-born Christopher Taylor, a.k.a. Trouble Over Tokyo, brought attention to himself in spring 2007, as a support artist for the local indie-pop band Garish. The question is, why would he choose the Alpine republic as a playground for his indie-soul-electro-pop music? By chance, a visitor from the Styrian city Graz met the English musician in a London pub a few years ago and invited him to play a few concerts in Styria. The rest is history and Trouble Over Tokyo is here to stay. more information

Ginga

The fact that Ginga is a band with big potential is something that has already been known in Austria for quite some time, but was not fully recognized. After their brilliant and outstanding performance at the Popfest in Vienna this year, there was no question that Ginga is probably the most promising band of the local pop scene. With their debut album "They Should Have Told Us", the four-member band first called attention to themselves in 2008. Songs like "Cinnamon" and "Fashion" were played at Austria's radio station FM4 in permanent rotation. Especially beyond Austrian borders, fans were enthusiastic about these wonderful pop songs. more information

Saint Lu

Born in the Upper Austrian City of Wels, Saint Lu is currently ambitioning to conquer the mainstream rock scene with her music. The 25 year old, who lives in Berlin, has already been hailed by the German press as a female Lenny Kravitz. more information

Anbuley

The Vienna-based singer and dancer Anbuley is currently in the spotlight and is making a name for herself with various successful projects and high flying producers around the globe. The daughter of Ghanian parents is momentarily one of the most popular figures in the European dubstep scene, which is proven by numerous collaborations with renowned producers like Bert On Beats and Stefan Mörth (Stereotype). Everything started as a Street Musician at Vienna's tourist hotspots like "Kärntner Strasse/Stephansdom". His very first song, "Unbreakable", immediately became a hit (best place #16) and spent 20 weeks in the Austrian Charts. The song was nominated for "Song of the year" at the "Austrian Amadeus Music Awards" and has been the most played song in the Austrian radios in 2010. In October his first Album "Sincerely Me" (Pate Records / edel distribution) was released and in March 2011 James will be a member of the third season of "Dancing Stars" in the Austrian TV ORF. James is most known for his energetic and emotion filled live performances.

BAUCHKLANG 23.1. at 6.30pm - Fringe – Palais des Festival

Despite the existing potential, there are only a few local musicians and bands that make the jump to international success. It takes something really special and extraordinary to arouse enthusiasm among music fans outside of Austria. A group that has met all the requirements from the outset in order to make this successful step, is the Lower Austrian vocal troupe Bauchklang. The quintet can boast of single-handedly reviving and saving the genre of "a capella" over into the new millennium.

With their mix of virtuosic vocal mastery, mouth percussion and human beatbox, the five vocal artists Andi Fraenzl, Alex Böck, Gerald Huber, Christian Birawsky and Philipp Sageder generate a unique overall sound, which has also become very popular with thousands of music fans beyond local borders.
