3. Amadeus Austrian Music Awards



Amadeus Austrian Music Awards: Anna F. and Skero are the big winners of the evening

On the 16th of September 2010, the Austrian music industry celebrated their heroes at the annual Amadeus Austrian Music Awards in the Wiener Stadthalle and honored the winners with the coveted trophy. The awards were presented in thirteen categories. Big winners of the evening were the Styrian pop singer Anna F. and the Upper Austrian hip hopper Skero. Toni Stricker was awarded for his lifetime work as a violinist and composer.

It was a lavish celebration. Almost everybody who is anybody in the Austrian music industry came to pay their respects to these year's winners of the Amadeus Austrian Music Awards. There were some surprises, which is also due to last year's newly introduced public voting. Not all supposed favorites in every category were able to carry away the prize. This year for instance, the repeatedly nominated band **Bunny Lake** left the evening empty-handed.

Also in the jazz sector, the nominated Sabina Hank and Ernst Molden were not able to mobilize enough fans. Most fans voted for Anna F. and hip-hopper Skero. Both were honored with two awards. The young Styrian songwriter received the much sought-after awards in the categories Best Album and Best Rock/Pop Act. Skero won in the categories Hip Hop and Best Song of the Year (for the song "Kabinenparty")

A touching moment was the bestowal of the Lifetime Achievement Award to the violinist and composer Toni Stricker. In his long career, the now 80-year-old played with various jazz legends, including Joe Zawinul and Attila Zoller. The jury of the Amadeus Awards praised Toni Stricker as the "epitome of swing violinists".

Two winners were already clear from the beginning. The FM4 Award went to the extremely talented Lower Austrian drum 'n' bass producer duo Camo & Krooked. The Best Live Act Award was given to the St. Pölten vocal troupe **Bauchklang**.

4. Ernst Krenek Prize 2010

Ernst Krenek Prize 2010 goes to composer Richard Dünser

The Ernst Krenek Prize of the City of Vienna 2010 is awarded to Richard Dünser for his composition "Radek". The prize, donated by the City of Vienna on the occasion of the 85th birthday of Ernst Krenek in 1985, is awarded every two years and is endowed with 8.000 €. It is awarded for a composition or a musical work under the proposal of a jury. Vienna's Councillor for Culture, Andreas Mailath-Pokorny, will present the award in Autumn 2010. <u>further information</u>

Sound Park Austria 3: POP
At the moment the the London music scene is sizzling in the district of Camden. One of the landmarks of the district is the venue " The Forge ". In May 2010 the Austrian Cultural Forum London took this advantage and initiated the new event series " Sound Park Austria " in The Forge , which is curated by the London-based Tyrolean bass player Philipp M. Moll . The goal is to bring musicians from Austria to the UK and introduce Austrian contemporary music apart from the classical tradition, in order to provide a glimpse into the richly differentiated, vibrant Austrian music scene, while at the same time encouraging the exchange with British artists. The artists have the possibility to make new contacts, discuss their work and influence each other. For the third session of the " Sound Park Austria ", four musicians have been invited to perform a concert each and collaborate with each other.
